NEVER call your child across the road!

WALKING

We encourage you to walk with your children to and from school if possible as it:

- Helps improve your child's fitness and health (and yours).
- Gets them to arrive at school awake, alert and ready to learn.
- Means less cars on the road making it safer for everyone and reduces pollution.
- Helps your child learn road sense skills and become familiar with their community.

IT IS COOL TO BUS TO SCHOOL

As a small rural school we rely heavily on buses. If students are unable to walk to school due to distance, please take advantage of our bus service. We actively encourage responsible behaviour on buses so bus travel is positive for everyone. We have bus stops close proximity to many of your homes and the bus will ensure your child gets safely to and from the school gate.

If you pick up or drop your children at the bus stop......

- · Wait on the same side of the road as the bus stop.
- · Park your car well away from the bus stop or other children.
- Teach your children about bus behaviour.
- Encourage your children to wait quietly at the stop and not play games that could see them running onto the road.
- Teach your children the safest route from your house to the bus stop the route with the fewest road crossings and least traffic.
- If your children have to cross the road after getting off the bus, teach them
 to wait until the bus has moved away and they can see the road clearly.

DRIVING Use the Community Carpark

If you need to drive, please observe the following practices:

DROPPING OFF

Use the community carpark next to the school grounds and walk the children to school using the school walkway.

Watch out for other cars entering the carpark and move quickly, but safely to the walkway.

PICKING UP

- You can collect your children from the hall deck area at the end of the school day.
- Children will be seated in car lines outside the hall on fine days and on the hall deck on wet days.
- <u>Do not</u> ask your child to meet you at the walkway or carpark as it is not safe practice.
